ICL members come from all walks of life, bringing with them a lifetime of experiences. Most members are retired or semi-retired.

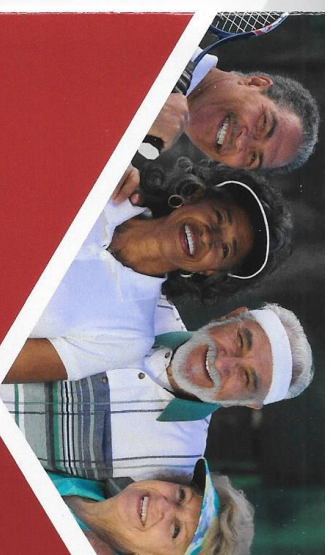
The membership fee is \$45 for the Fall and Spring Semesters
